Judges: Judges commitment is through the Finals per State Rules If a judge is called upon and does not judge the round the school forfeits that judges pay and will be fined (per state rules).

1. One judge for one to four IE contestants
2. Two judges for five to eight IE contestants
3. One judge for one to three LD contestants
4. One judge for one to three Public Forum Judges
5. A full slate is required to bring a minimum of six judges (three per day)
