10		intents and p	ourposes as part of the Constitution when
11		ratified by tl	he legislatures of three-fourths of the several
12		states withir	n seven years from the date of its submission by
13		the Congress	5:
14			ARTICLE –
15		SECTION 1:	The Second Amendment of the US Constitution
16			under the Bill of Rights shall hereby be
17			repealed.
18		SECTION 2:	The Congress shall have power to enforce this
19			article by appropriate legislation.
