

A Bill to Repeal the JASTA

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1. Section 1: Purpose, Definitions, and Findings

2. (a) PURPOSE—To repeal the JASTA.

3. (b) DEFINITIONS

4. (i) “JASTA” shall be defined as the United States Law “Justice Against
5. Sponsors of Terrorism Act.”

6. (c) FINDINGS

7. (i) JASTA has damaged America’s reputation at home and abroad

8. (ii) JASTA sets a dangerous precedent by allowing US citizens to sue foreign

9. governments

10. In United States court for any perceived wrongful act made by that foreign government

11. or that foreign government’s agents on a US citizen.

12. Section 2: Effective Date

13. This Act shall go into effect immediately upon passage

A Resolution to End the Use of Zika Sprays that Kill Honeybees

- 1 **WHEREAS:** Sprays used to exterminate the larvae of the mosquito that carries the
- 2 zika virus have negative impacts upon honeybees; and
- 3 **WHEREAS:** the insecticide used to kill larvae cannot discriminate between honeybees
- 4 and mosquitos; and
- 5 **WHEREAS:** After being sprayed with the zika killing aerial pesticide, millions of honeybees
- 6 can die, resulting in lack of pollination for many plants and flowers; and
- 7 **WHEREAS:** Many species of fruit bearing trees and plants would not be pollinated and
- 8 would surely die out should the day come where the honeybee is no longer available; and
- 9 **WHEREAS:** Honeybees have been recently added to the endangered species list following
- 10 the death of honeybees after being sprayed with zika aerial pesticides;
- 11 **THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Student Congress here assembled end the use of
- 12 the insecticide used to kill the mosquito that spreads zika and that unintentionally kills
- 13 honeybees. Let this resolution be enacted by January 1st 2017. Once implemented, all
- 14 violators will pay a fine according to the degree of their violation.

A Bill to Standardize and Reinforce the Castle Doctrine

Section 1: *Definitions*

Whereas(a): A *Stand Your Ground Clause* allows a defendant to use deadly force in self defense without initially retreating. A *Duty to Retreat Clause* is a law stating that one may only use deadly force in self defense after retreating until they could retreat no further.

Section 2: *Application by Location*

Whereas(a): Any person, while in the safety of their home, vehicle, or workplace who is confronted by an intruder who has forcefully entered said home, vehicle, or workplace shall not be required to retreat or to notify the authorities prior to using deadly force upon the intruder. Furthermore, any person found to be acting in self defense of an intruder while in their home, vehicle, or workplace shall not be indicted for any injury or death that may result from their self defensive actions. Moreover, an intruder into a defendant's workplace need not enter forcefully to qualify for self defense if the intruder threatens the clerk or employees of the workplace.

Whereas(b): Any person, while not in the safety of their home, vehicle, or workplace who is confronted by a belligerent party shall have a *Duty to Retreat* as far as possible before resorting to deadly force in the form of self defense. Failing to retreat as far as possible or until one reaches their home, vehicle, or workplace will result in all actions of the defendant being tried as though they were not in self defense and all protections contained in this legislation be rendered null and void.

Section 3: *Confliction Legislation*

Whereas(a): All conflicting state legislation is hereby declared null and void.

Therefore, BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT: Persons acting in self defense and under the above conditions be exempt from all relevant indictment related to their self defense.
