ENTRY PROCEDURES: PLEASE READ! **Entries should be submitted through tabroom.com by 5:00 pm Monday, November 14 @ neverland.tabroom.com**, or through email at dsmith@putnamcityschools.org. Please refer to the OSSAA manual about late entries and add/drop fees for the tournament. Per the new OSSAA rules, all OO's must be available at the tournament if a protest is filed. If you would like to turn in a paper or digital copy at registration you may still do so. Please email digital copies to dsmith@putnamcityschools.org.

ENTRY CONFIRMATION: If you do not receive your entry confirmation and revised schedule by Thursday, November 17, please contact me.

JUDGES: All judges and their qualifications are due Wednesday, November 16 before 3:00pm. - A school must provide one coach OR *a person who meets the qualifications for judging* to serve as a judge for each of the following in which the team has entries:

- One (1) IE Judge per twelve (12) individual event entries
- One (1) LD Judge per four (4) LD debate entries
- One (1) CX Judge per two (4) CX debate entries
- One (1) PFD Judge per two (2) PFD debate entries

Failure to provide judges will result in an additional flat fee (see OSSAA book for amounts). **At this time, there are no limits to entries as long as everyone provides required judges.**

All 5A and 6A IE's, Policy and Lincoln Douglas and PFD debate will be held as well as Novice in all events. **Novice events will run only if there are 3 or more individuals/teams registered in the event.** We will be running three prelim rounds of debate on Friday, and will break all wins to Saturday.

DROPS AND ADDS: Entry fees will be assessed as of Tuesday at 4:00pm. We will follow OSSAA rules and guidelines, which means we will be charging for late adds/drops as well.

SCHOOL RULES:

- *No Smoking (including E-Cigs), drugs, or alcohol in the building or anywhere on our campus at all by anyone. We must disqualify any student smoking on our campus.
- *No food or drinks in the classrooms.
- *Students should not enter a classroom until a judge arrives.

ARRIVAL ON FRIDAY:

Putnam City's school day does not end until 3:10 pm. However, you are welcome to arrive as early as 2:15 pm. Please enter in the front of the school through "Pirate Hall." We will hold in the auditorium until 3:30 pm, at which time we will move to the cafeteria. The first round will begin at 4:00pm. BUSES: Please park buses in the lot directly behind our athletic training facility (in front of our baseball field). This is located on the east side of the school, north of the baseball fields. You will enter the parking lot from NW 50th Street onto Pirate Cove. Due to bus traffic at the end of the school day, it will be easiest to park and walk from the designated parking area. Our buses flow through the same area from east to west. **You will get stuck if you get in the bus line...so go to the star on the map. See map and picture below on the next page.**
