Please make every effort to meet your judging requirement and to ensure that your judges are in close communication with you.

Awards:

We will award trophies to the top 6 competitors/teams in all events. Congress participants will receive trophies for Presiding Officers, Outstanding, Superior, and Merit Speakers. Sweepstakes- plaques for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place, large and small school programs

Supervision:

It is expected that every team has adult supervision at this tournament- a parent, coach, program volunteer, etc. Remember that adults working with our competitors must have current PA clearances. **If it is brought to our attention that you have left your competitor(s) alone at the school without adult oversight from your school or program, they will be disqualified and the administration at your school will be contacted.**
