- As decided at our May 2016 coaches meeting, there will be three rounds of debate in **ALL DIVISIONS.**
- Arrive by 8:00 AM, with the first round to start before 9:00 AM. The final round is expected to begin at approximately 1:30PM, with the awards ceremony immediately following its conclusion. Note: We will be attempting to get the first round of debate started as close to 8:30 as possible. Fifteen minutes after the round is posted, all late teams will forfeit their first round.
- Entry fees are \$23 per debate team.
- Food will be provided for the students for a fee. Coaches and judges will have food provided for them at no cost.
- Students will be expected to dress appropriately, ties and dress shoes for boys and modest skirts or pants-suits for girls. Students must show respect for the facility and each other.
- Every team must fulfill their judging requirement of one judge for every two Policy Teams.
- In addition to the judging requirement, every team must bring one adult -- usually the coach -- to assist with the running of the tournament.

- For drops that are made by 5pm on Wednesday, October 4th, schools will be credited 50% of the entry fee for those drops. No credits will be issued for drops made after 5pm on Wednesday, October 4th. Drops on the day of the tournament are frowned upon. Adds the day of the tournament are impossible.
