Greetings, from the Center of the Universe! This is the affectionate nickname for our Town of Ashland, Virginia, located in the "center" of Hanover County. Atlee High School wishes to extend an invitation to your school's Speech & Debate team(s) to attend our Speech & Debate Invitational. Please review the information below and respond to the email address above with inquires and interests.

**EVENTS:** The tournament will offer both VHSL <u>Speech & Debate</u> events! December Debate topics and all VHSL rules will apply to this tournament, and our events are listed below:

1. **Policy**; this will be an open/varsity event, which will offer two preliminary rounds, followed by a third final round based on prelim results.

<u>2017-2018 CX topic</u>: **Resolved**: The United States federal government should substantially increase its funding and/or regulation of elementary and/or secondary education in the United States.

2. **Lincoln–Douglas**, open/varsity event.

<u>December Topic</u>: Resolved: Wealthy nations have an obligation to provide development assistance to other nations.

3. **Public Forum**; open/varsity event.

<u>December Topic</u>: Resolved: NCAA student athletes ought to be recognized as employees under the Fair Labor Standards Act.

4. **Student Congress** legislation has already been posted on Tabroom (<a href="http://cotu.tabroom.com">http://cotu.tabroom.com</a>) however, we will also accept new legislation due to the postponement:

Student Congress will consist of one open division, limited to 30 seats, but possibly a second chamber may be available and added, in which students may write one piece of DIEV legislation of their choice, and then submit by Thursday, December 14<sup>th</sup> to me: brcarr@hcps.us

I will send out any new legislation by the morning of Friday, December 15<sup>th</sup> to registrants.

\*\*\* No need to bring legislation, I will print them out for the tournament! \*\*\*

5. **Speech Events** which will be offered: Extemporaneous Speaking, Impromptu Speaking, Original Oratory, Prose Interpretation, Poetry Interpretation, Storytelling, Dramatic Interpretation, Humorous Interpretation, HI&DI Duo, and **Improvisation Team** (Non-VHSL, \$30, up to 4 members per team is permitted) & **Original Spoken Word** (Non-VHSL, individual speech entry cost.)

\* Students MAY double-enter in speech categories, except Extemp & Improv, for an additional entry fee. Sorry, no crossing over with Debate events.

+ No disqualifications for using speech cripts this early in the season!

**JUDGES:** Each school is responsible for providing judges:

Policy & Public Forum teams, one (1) judge for every three (or fraction of) entered;

Lincoln–Douglas, (1) judge for every two (or fraction of) entered;

Student Congress, (1) judge for every five (or fraction of) entered;

Speech (Forensics) Events, (1) judge for every five (or fraction of) entered.

A limited number of judges will be available for hire at a charge of \$60.00 for the day.

**FEES:** Schools are limited to 6 entries in each category/speech event; & 2 Improv teams.

- > \$20.00 for each member of the Student Congress

- ➤ \$60 per hired judge (limited availability; request early)

## DROPS:

Drops (for any reason) are permitted up to 48-hours before the tournament with no penalty. Drops within 48-hours require schools to honor the entry fees AND still require the original judging quota. If the original judging quota is not met upon registration, students may not be able to compete and there will be a \$60 dropped judge fee.
