<u>Events</u>

Novice and Varsity divisions in Team Debate, Lincoln Douglas Debate, Oral Interpretation, and Duo Interpretation will be offered, if entries warrant. All events will follow NSDA rules with the exception of Oral Interpretation, which will adhere to CFL rules.

Rounds/Elimination Rounds

In Public Forum Debate, teams are guaranteed five preliminary rounds but we have provided six every year! It is our goal to hold five preliminary rounds in both Policy Debate

and Lincoln-Douglas Debate, if entries warrant. Additionally, Policy Debate and Lincoln-Douglas Debate will break to Quarters; Public Forum Debate will advance to Double-Octofinals. In Individual Events, students are guaranteed five prelim rounds, breaking to Semis. Congressional Debate will have three preliminary sessions and break to Semi Finals.

Entry Limits

Initially, six entries in each Individual Event, LD and CX will be accepted. In Congressional Debate schools are allowed ten entries. In PF, schools will be granted eight teams initially; and all remaining entries will be waitlisted. In the event that your entries are waitlisted, we will remove your students as soons as space is available. Double entry is allowed in speech events (no triple entry) only.

Entry Deadlines:

This website will begin accepting entries on September 11th . The deadline for entering competitors is Wednesday, October 25th. All late entries, thereafter, should be emailed to the tournament director at <u>Courtney.Chipman@browardschools.com</u>.

<u>Judges</u>

Please bring 1 trained judge for every 5 entries in Individual Events, 1 trained judge for every 2 entries in LD/CX/ PF; if you have congress entries: include 1 trained judge for 5 debaters in Congressional debate.

On Tournament Day

To facilitate a prompt, fair tournament, we will follow this procedure: At 3PM, in the Media Center, we will open registration. Coaches will have an areas to submit fees and meal tickets will be disseminated, along with copies of codes, ballots, etc. Judges will also need to check in in the Media Center.

Special Note: Registration is not the time to report drops. If you have drops on Friday morning, please call 754-323-1759 or 954-648-0599; please be clear which name and event is to be eliminated.

Students will be directed to go to the auditorium upon arrival. Please see to it that someone from the school is there with them. <u>Please do not arrive later than 3:45 as we will start</u> <u>Extemp Draw and Round One promptly at 4:30, and you will find it extremely</u> <u>difficult to get onto the campus due to dismissal traffic.</u> In order to facilitate a prompt start, and therefore a reasonable end time, please be sure your judges are on our campus before our dismissal begins! On Saturday, Extemp Draw and judge call will begin promptly at 7:30 AM!!

Students and Coaches should enter Nova High School along the 39th Street Gate. We are asking that cars to enter on the westernmost gate, closest to our gymnasium. There will be a member of our Security Staff and Nova Debate Students directing cars to the last five rows in that parking lot and parking can extend to east gate. If cars attempt to enter the east gate where the buses line up at 3:30, they will be directed out of the parking lot. Once faculty exits the campus on Friday there will be even more spots available along the gate labeled Senior Lot. On Saturday, Broward County has Driver's Ed in that lot, please park in the main lot in front of school off of College Avenue; this will be more convenient to awards in the auditorium.
