

A Bill to Establish a Federally Funded Cybersecurity College Scholarship to Protect America's Internet Infrastructure

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2	SECTION 1.	Any qualified student interested in studying a subject relevant to
3		computers, technology, or the internet may apply, and if select, have the
4		Federal Government fully cover the cost of their education at a public
5		university under the condition that selected students successfully
6		complete their degrees and commit to working for the federal
7		government for 6 consecutive years. The scholarship will be available for
8		a maximum of 5,000 qualified students each year.
9	SECTION 2.	A qualified student will be defined as a student that is an American
10		citizen at the time of their application who have also successfully
11		completed high school with a minimum of a 3.4/4.0 GPA and have been
12		accepted to an accredited public university in the U.S.
13	SECTION 3.	\$200 million dollars will be made available to the Department of
14		Education in order to oversee, manage, and develop the program and is
15		authorized to create any additional standards and qualifications of
16		applicants they deem are needed.
17	SECTION 4.	This bill will take effect immediately.
10	SECTION 5	All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void

A Bill to Enact a Financial Transaction Tax to Fund the Highway Trust Fund

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

1	SECTION 1.	A 0.1% tax on all financial transactions shall be instituted.
2	All revenue fro	om the tax shall go towards the Highway Trust Fund.
3	SECTION 2.	A. Financial transactions shall include but not be limited to
4	cash receipts,	deposit corrections, requisitions, purchase orders, invoices,
5	travel expense	e reports, PCard charges, and journal entries.
6	B. The Highwa	y Trust Fund is America's federal trust fund that finances
7	most federal g	overnment spending for highways and mass transit.
8	SECTION 3.	The Department of Treasury shall implement the tax, and
9	the Internal R	evenue service shall collect revenue and distribute it to the
10	Highway Trust	Fund.
11	SECTION 4.	This legislation shall take effect immediately.
12	SECTION 5.	All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared
13	null and void.

A Bill to Back the Kurds in the Fight Against ISIS

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

1	SECTION 1.	The US shall send \$200 million annually in \$50 million	
2	quarterly installments in military aid to the Kurds.		
3	SECTION 2.	A. Military Aid shall include, but not be limited to; guns,	
4	tanks, drones, and armored vehicles.		
5		B. The Kurds shall be defined as the ethnic group that	
6	inhabits a mountainous region straddling the borders of Turkey, Iraq, Syria,		
7	Iran and Armenia.		
8	SECTION 3.	A. The Department of Defense will oversee the	
9	implementation of this aid to the Kurdish Regional Government and will		
10	conduct quart	terly audits to determine the effectiveness of aid.	
11		B. The DOD audits will consist of a detailed report of military	
12	aid effectiven	ess to congress and the bill will need biannual approval by	
13	congress to continue.		
14	SECTION 4.	This bill will go into effect immediately upon passage.	
15	SECTION 5.	All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared	
16	null and void.
