Please note that The Navy and Old Gold Debate and Speech Exhibition is a Finals qualifier for the National Tournament of Champions (TOC) in Public Forum and and a semis qualifier in Lincoln Douglas Debate. We are also a qualifier to the TOC in Speech and a bid tournament for the NIETOC. The tournament is also a qualifier for the Louisiana High School Speech League Tournament of Champions in all sanctioned events. We will again offer a division of debate in the World Schools format.

Speech events will be held on Friday and Saturday with each guaranteed 4 preliminary rounds for each event before going into the required elimination rounds depending on the entry. Debate will have six preliminary rounds.

ALL debaters may only enter that event - no cross entries will be allowed. Brackets will not be broken in any debate event.

The Lincoln Douglas topic will be the September/October NFL topic.
