Cherokee High School Speech and Debate hopes you will consider joining us Friday night, December 8th and Saturday, December 9th at our first tournament: Cherokee Winter Challenge. Our team is honored to host you at the final forensics challenge of 2017!

If you are in town Friday night, we will offer Big Questions (BQ) Debate. When providing judges for BQ, please note, it is acceptable to register 3rd or 4th year debate students to judge. For dinner, pizza, drinks, and snacks will be provided for students to purchase. The hospitality lounge will be open for coaches and judges. Dress casual. In fact, please wear your ugly holiday sweater! You may win a prize!

On Saturday, a variety of events will be offered. In debate, we will offer Novice and Varsity Public Forum (NSDA December resolution) and Novice and Varsity Lincoln Douglas (NSDA Nov/Dec resolution).

In speech, we will offer Dramatic Interp, Humorous Interp, Duo Interp, Program of Oral Interp, Original Oratory, Informative Speaking, Extemporaneous Speaking, and Impromptu. Triple entering in events is prohibited. For an extra challenge, speech students are encouraged to try out the two session, open chamber Student Congress we will hold Saturday.

On Saturday, students will have concessions available throughout the day and lunch options will be made available. A hospitality lounge will be available for coaches and judges. Students/coaches/judges should NOT leave campus for lunch as we plan on keeping our schedule moving as fast as possible.

COSTS and FEES:

School Registration is \$25 Each Lincoln Douglas entry is \$20 Each Public Forum entry is \$25 Each Individual Event entry is \$20

BQ and Congress are free of charge!

Hired Judges are as follows:

- Teams need to provide one judge per two Public Forum teams. Hired judges are \$100 for Public Forum, or a portion thereof at \$50 per entry.

- One judge for every two Lincoln Douglas entries. Hired judges are \$100 for Lincoln Douglas, or a portion thereof at \$50 per entry.

- One judge per five Individual Events entries. Hired judges are \$75 for Individual Events, or a portion thereof at \$15 per entry.

Any judging obligations that are NOT covered by the registration deadline WILL result in nonrefundable hired judge fees being added to the school's invoice.

Parking

Parking at Cherokee High School can be a bit of a challenge because we do not have many options. Here is what I would suggest:

Buses should drop off students in front of our new gym (after turning into CHS at the light, turn immediately right, then turn immediately left to unload students in the bus lane). Buses should then proceed to Canton Elementary School (to the right of CHS if looking at the new gym) and park behind their elementary school.

Cars – and any vehicles that can fit into a normal size parking space – should park in the spaces available in front of the new gym. The ACT will be given at Cherokee the same day as our tournament, and those students and teachers involved in testing will be parking in the spaces closest to our mobile classrooms which are to the left of the high school.
