Judge Quotas

- First-year outs may judge all events/levels and your open-level competitors may judge all events in novice only.
- •Judging quotas are 1 for 5 IE entries (not competitor-entries), 1 dedicated congress scorer per team entering congress, 1 per 3 LD entries, 1 per 3 PF teams, and 1 per 2 CX teams.

Congress

We will be offering two rounds of Congress on Friday and Super Congress on Saturday.

Debate Topics

- •Lincoln-Douglas will use the November/December topic. We will have Open and Novice divisions only.
- •Public Forum will use the November topic. We will have Open and Novice divisions only.
- •Cross Examination Debate will offer Open and Novice divisions only.

Individual Events

We will be offering individual events in the traditional A and B Patterns. We will be switching the order of A and B events to accommodate Extemp Prep. Although double booking is allowed, please note that our schedule is tight and getting to individual rounds is up to the competitor. Pattern A Events are: Duo Interpretation, Dramatic Interpretation, Extemporaneous, Editorial Commentary, Slam Poetry and Expository. Pattern B Events are: Interpretive Reading, Humorous Interpretation, Oratory, Duo Improvisation and Impromptu.

Registration

Registration is on Tabroom.com The final deadline for registration, changes, and drops is Wednesday November 1st at 5:00 p.m. and the registration site will close and lock entries at that point. No refunds for drops after that date. Extra fees for late adds will be collected at the tournament. We are trying to provide you with the best tournament experience possible, so please keep drops/adds, and judge no-shows to a minimum, as they are usually what causes a delay.
