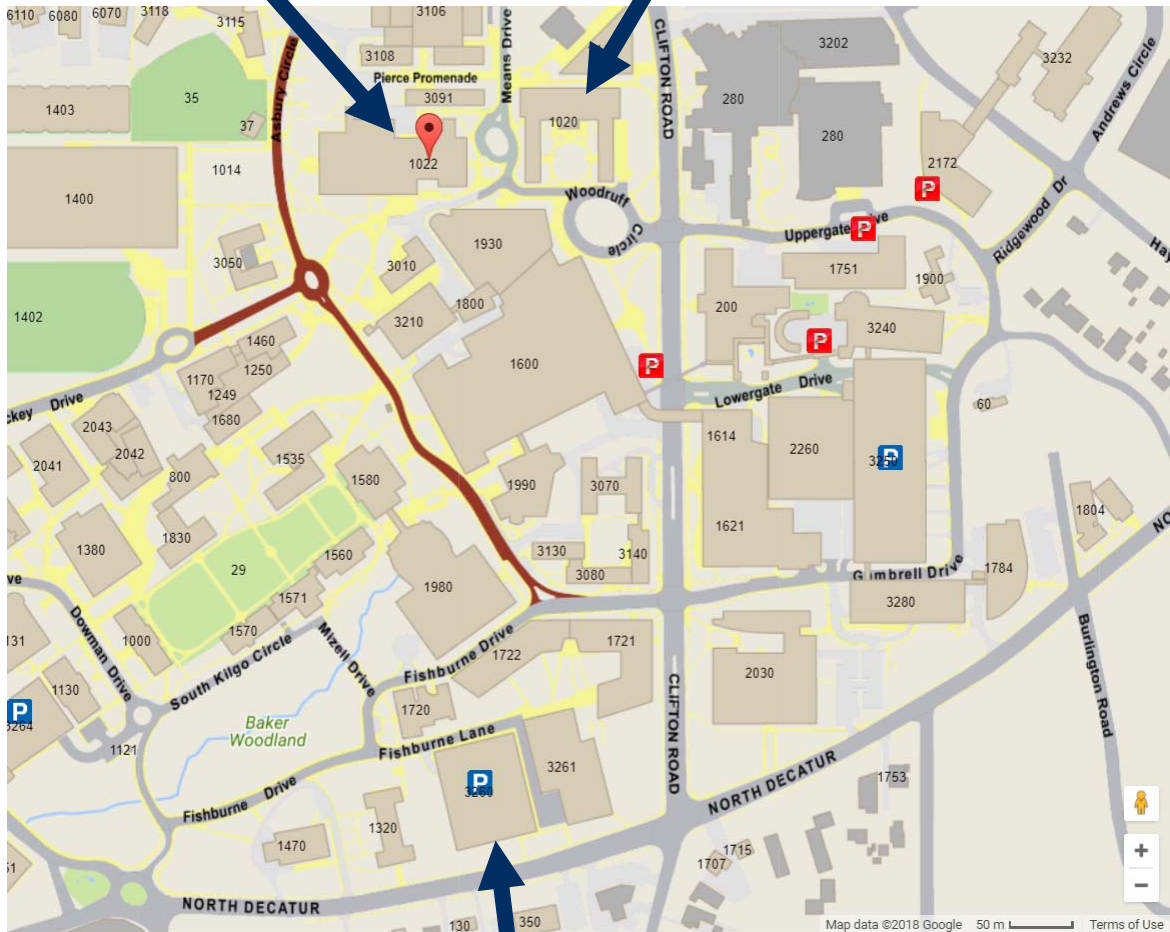

FOOD RECOMMENDATIONS

Walking Distance from Emory

Rise-n-Dine (1565 N Decatur Rd, Atlanta, GA 30307) – This breakfast place is very good. There's typically a short wait but it's worth it. Abby strongly recommends the Polish Omelette or the Pierogi Bowl if you're there for lunch. **Grade: A**

Dave's Cosmic Subs (1540 N Decatur Rd, Atlanta, GA 30307) – Look at the menu before you go or else they may yell at you. Southern Hospitality isn't really a thing here, but if your food is good – southern hospitality isn't needed. The subs here are much better than your basic sub from Subway/Quiznos. **Grade: B+**

Falafal King (1405 Oxford Road, Atlanta, GA 30307) – Abby and the local Emory crew love this place. **Grade: A-**

Other places: Lucky's Burger Brew is fine but I'd avoid Dragon Bowl. Ali's Cookies are good if you need a quick pick me up.

Close to Emory (Within 5 minute driving):

Community Q (1361 Clairmont Rd, Decatur, GA 30033) – This BBQ does Atlanta BBQ justice. It's no Fox Brothers, but the ribs and pork plates are high quality. Sides are pretty good too. **Grade: A**

Other Places: I've been happy with my meals at Rice Mac and Saigon Café is also good for the area.

North Druid Hills/Decatur Spots (10 minutes from Emory)

Newk's Eatery (2566 Briarcliff Rd NE, Atlanta, GA 30329) – This is another good option for a quick lunch – great sandwiches and salad combinations. **Grade: A-**

Revival (129 Church St, Decatur, GA 30030) – If money and time are not a factor – you should go to Revival. It is one of the best meals I've ever had in my life – you will need reservations (sometimes, days in advance). **Grade: A+**

General Muir (1540 Avenue Place B-230, Atlanta, GA 30329) - This is the best place in Emory Point. It's a contemporary spin on a New York style deli. All of the plates I've had here are excellent. You must also get the poutine if they have it when you go. **Grade: A-**

Café Bombay (2615 Briarcliff Rd NE, Atlanta, GA 30329) – This may be the best Indian food in Atlanta, we'll have it on Thursday night but if you want to go back – its solid. **Grade: A**

Dunwoody/Chamblee Spots (15-30 minutes from Emory, near some hotels):

Takorea (4474 Chamblee Dunwoody Rd, Dunwoody, GA 30338) – Unbelievable Korean Taco place – highly recommend the fried chicken tacos. **Grade: A**

Pho Bac (4897 Buford Hwy NE, Chamblee, GA 30341) – This is the best Vietnamese restaurant on Buford Hwy. **Grade: A**

Canton Cooks (The Exchange At Hammond, 5984 Roswell Rd NE, Atlanta, GA 30328) – Top sit-down Chinese restaurant near Marist/Perimeter area. **Grade: A-**

Personal Favorite for Breakfast:

Buttermilk Kitchen (4225 Roswell Rd NE, Atlanta, GA 30342) – This place is ridiculously good and worth whatever wait. This is a great spot for the Friday morning before the BFHS. I highly recommend the Chicken Biscuit. **Grade: A+**

Personal Favorite for Lunch:


















































































Café at Pharr (multiple locations)- I eat at this place once a week – I prefer the Chicken Walnut Salad plate but if you like more flavor the Curry Chicken Salad plate is great. The dressing for the Chicken Salad is amazing. **Grade: A**

Desserts:

ICE-NY (Pinetree Shopping Center, 5177 Buford Hwy NE, Doraville, GA 30340) – This is a MUST GO place. Originated in Thailand, these ice cream rolls promise to make you happy. Steve Schappaugh considered moving to Atlanta just for this place. Tell them Jeff Miller sent you (the owner loves us). **Grade: A+**

Sublime Donuts (2566 Briarcliff Rd NE, Atlanta, GA 30329) – Because you can never go wrong with a fancy donut. This is a great breakfast stop or just a dessert stop. **Grade: A+**

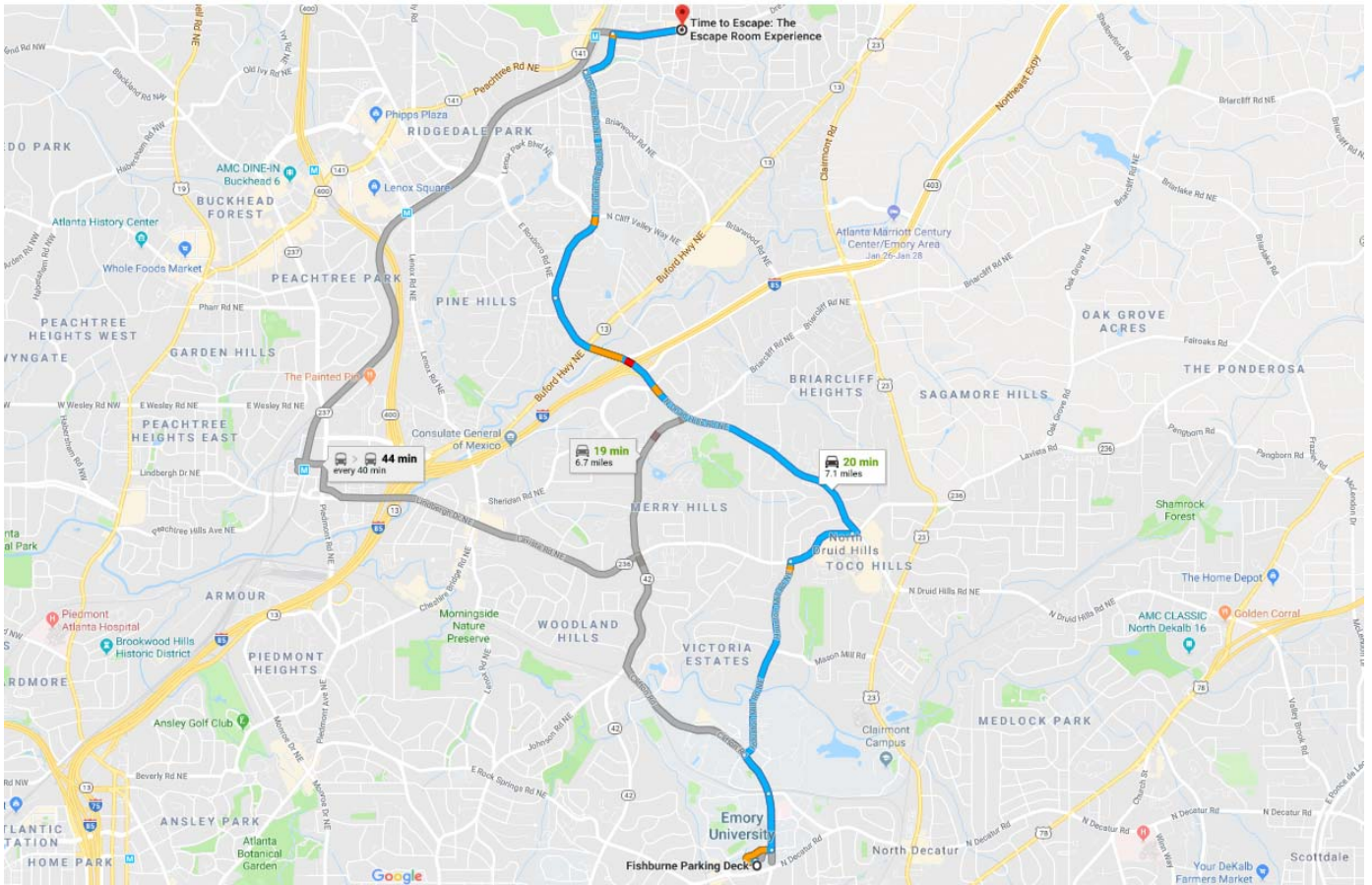
