DRIVING SOUTH ON I-5: TAKE EXIT #189 ON SR 526 WEST FOR 4 1/2 MILES. AT THE BOTTOM OF THE STEEP HILL TURN LEFT ON TO SR 525 SOUTH, (A.K.A. MUKILTEO SPEEDWAY) AND GO 1 1/3 MILES. TURN RIGHT ONTO HARBOUR POINTE BOULEVARD. PROCEED PAST HARBOUR POINTE MIDDLE SCHOOLS TO OUR CAMPUS.

DRIVING NORTH ON I-5. TAKE EXIT # 182 ONTO TO SR 525, AND TRAVEL 5 MILES AT THE FOURTH TRAFFIC LIGHT TURN LEFT ONTO HARBOUR POINTE BLVD. PROCEED PAST HARBOUR POINTE MIDDLE SCHOOL TO OUR CAMPUS.
