

2018 Northeast IN NSDA District Congress

Congress Information:

- **Deadline to submit legislation is December 1st. That gives the committee time to select the docket and set the legislation sent out a month before the tournament. Each school is allowed to submit up to 4 pieces of legislation, with the committee choosing up to 2 from each school (unless we need to select more). Please refer to the NSDA TEMPLATES in structuring your legislation.**
- **My goal is to send out the Congress docket by December 13th (one month prior to the tournament).**
- **We will need 8 schools to qualify for a senate chamber and then at least 30 total entries in the House to be able to send 2 to nationals.**
- **When you register via tabroom.com, you will be told how many entries you can enter in the House. Each chapter can enter 2 in the Senate.**
- **Disregard the January 6th deadline. Our deadline will be Wednesday, January 10th to allow for any last minute student memberships to participate.**
- **Please list ONE available judge if you enter Congress that the Northwest District could use to judge their tournament.**
- **There are no entry fees to participate in District Congress**

Big Questions Debate:

- **We will be holding this event on April 14th at Concord so we can share judges with Northwest IN. The winning debater will qualify for the national tournament, so this would be a great event for any of your students who do not qualify in another event.**
