This tournament will use **Canadian National Debate Format (CNDF)**. There will be two rounds on a prepared topic (below) and one impromptu round, which will be announced at the tournament. As this is a developmental tournament with a focus on allowing novice debaters to practice enhancing their skills, the times have been slightly modified from the standard CNDF times. The speaking times will be as follows:

Protected time will be one minute at the beginning and end of the 5 minute speeches, at which point the debaters are not allowed to give POI's (points of information). Summary speeches are all protected time.

Registration

In order to register for the tournament, debaters should be in grades 7 or under. As we do have limited spacing, registration will be held on a first come, first serve basis. A confirmation email will be sent to all teams once they are registered.
