

A Step By Step Guide to Online Balloting For Speech Judges Using Tabroom.com

This document is accurate as of 1/25/18 and requires a tabroom.com account. If you don't have a tabroom account you need to create one first.

To create an account

1. Go to tabroom.com and click on Sign Up. Follow the directions to create an account. Entering your cell phone number is highly recommended as you will receive text messages with judging assignments.
2. After creating your account, log in and look for "Link your person to a judge" in the yellow Your Account section. Click on it.
3. You'll see the school or schools you judge for. You'll need to claim yourself before you can online ballot. The coach of the school also needs to approve it before you can ballot electronically. Don't worry, they'll get an email when from tabroom when you claim your record.

To ballot electronically

1. Log into your account. If you have rounds assigned to you that have been made public, you'll see them on your screen. It looks something like this:

2. You'll see the name of the category, room, start time and a list of entries and a green button that says "Start Round." Head to your room and get ready to judge! Click on the start round button when the round starts. This lets the tabroom know that you've begun your round. It also takes you to the ballot/critique entry screen.

6. WAIT! You aren't done yet! There is 1 more step. You need to confirm the ranks for the students. If they are correct, click the Green button. If you need to make a change, click the Red button.
 - a. You'll notice that the students are now in rank order, not speaker order. You can view the round in speaker order by clicking on the word Spoke on the top of the screen.

You'll have to contact the tournament staff to make any further changes**

You are able to **write more comments/feedback** until the end of the tournament; you just may not change scores.

7. Once you confirm your ballot, the round is complete. You can proceed to your next round. Since there is nothing to hand in, you can skip the long lines at the ballot table!

Final thoughts;

If you need to make a change to your ballot after confirming it, you need go to the tab room.

Don't let your computer be a distraction to listening and watching the round. The job of the judge remains the same, despite the use of technology.

It's always good to check the posted schedule. There are a bunch of reasons why you might not receive a text, despite everyone's best efforts.
