A RESOLUTION TO REFORM THE ECPA TO PROHIBIT WARRANTLESS SEARCHES AND SIEZURES

- 1. **WHEREAS**, the federal Electronic Communications Privacy Act (ECPA) is the primary federal law
- 2. that specifies standards for government access to electronic communications; and
- 3. **WHEREAS** the ECPA has not undergone a significant revision since it was enacted in 1986, before
- 4. the online services we use today existed; and
- 5. **WHEREAS** emails do not receive the same 4th Amendment protections as physical letters stored
- 6. in filing cabinets; therefore, be it
- 7. **RESOLVED** by the student congress here assembled that the Electronics
- 8. Communications Privacy Act be amended to require that all federal agencies obtain a search
- 9. warrant based on probable cause, to compel internet service providers to deliver access to
- 10. subscriber digital records, including emails, text messages, stored documents, and geographical
- 11. location information.

A Resolution to Withdraw from NAFTA

1	WHEREAS, the North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA) has outsourced
2	American manufacturing jobs due to a surplus of cheap labor from Mexican
3	factory workers; and
4	WHEREAS, this has had severe ramifications on the American economy; and
5	WHEREAS, NAFTA has contributed to a drastic increase in the American trade deficit;
6	and
7	WHEREAS, NAFTA has not lived up to its expectations with regards to benefitting the
8	global economy; now, therefore, be it
9	RESOLVED, By the Congress here assembled that the United States hereby withdraws
10	from the North American Free Trade Agreement

Assault Weapons Ban of 2018

1	BE II ENAC	TED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:
2	SECTION 1:	It shall be unlawful for a person to import, sell, manufacture transfer, or possess,
3		in or affecting interstate or foreign commerce, a semiautomatic assault firearm as
4		well as ammunition designed to feed such devices.
5	SECTION 2:	Semiautomatic firearms are defined as utilizing a portion of the energy of a firing
6		cartridge to extract the fired cartridge case and chamber the next round; and
7		requiring a separate pull of the trigger to fire each cartridge. Firearms proposed as
8		contraband at https://www.congress.gov/bill/115th-congress/house-bill/5087/text
9		shall be included in this act.
10	SECTION 3:	§1 shall not apply to the importation for, manufacture for, sale to, transfer to, or
11		possession by law enforcement officers or military personnel at any level; nor to
12		security of nuclear materials; nor to individuals in good standing who have retired
13		from law enforcement or military positions.
14	SECTION 4:	The Attorney General and the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and
15		Explosives (ATF) shall implement and enforce the provisions of this act.
16	SECTION 5:	This law shall take effect upon passage, and shall not apply to possession, sale, or
17		transfer or transfer of any semiautomatic firearms otherwise lawfully possessed
18		under Federal law.
19	SECTION 6:	All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
