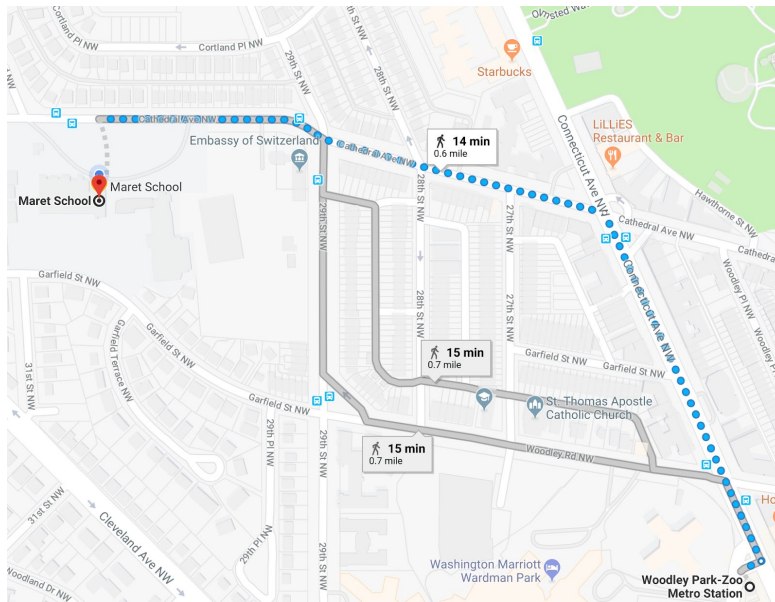

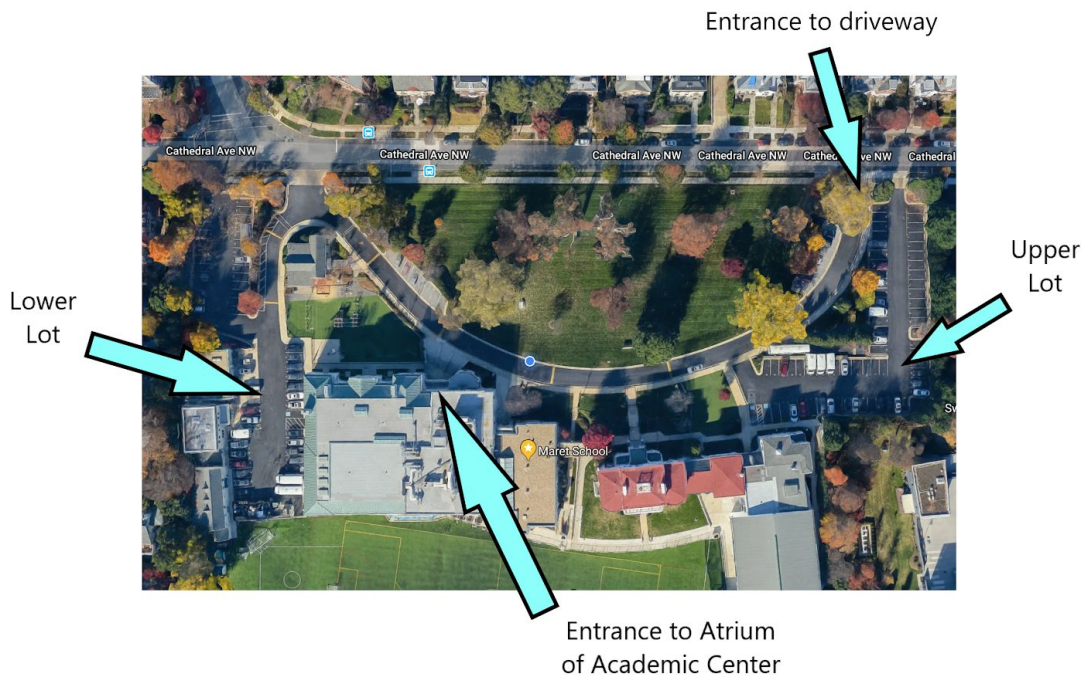

GETTING HERE ([3000 Cathedral Ave. NW, Washington, DC](#))

We are accessible by Metro on the Red Line (Woodley Park stop). From the Metro, it is about a 15 minute walk to campus.



If you drive, you can park on-campus in either the upper or lower lots.



All rounds will be held in the Academic Center. The Academic Center is the building to the right of the large white building with the columns (Woodley Building) as you face it. Enter the Academic Center through the Atrium, which is directly off the driveway.

Students can stay in the Atrium on the 2nd floor or the cafeteria on the 1st floor.

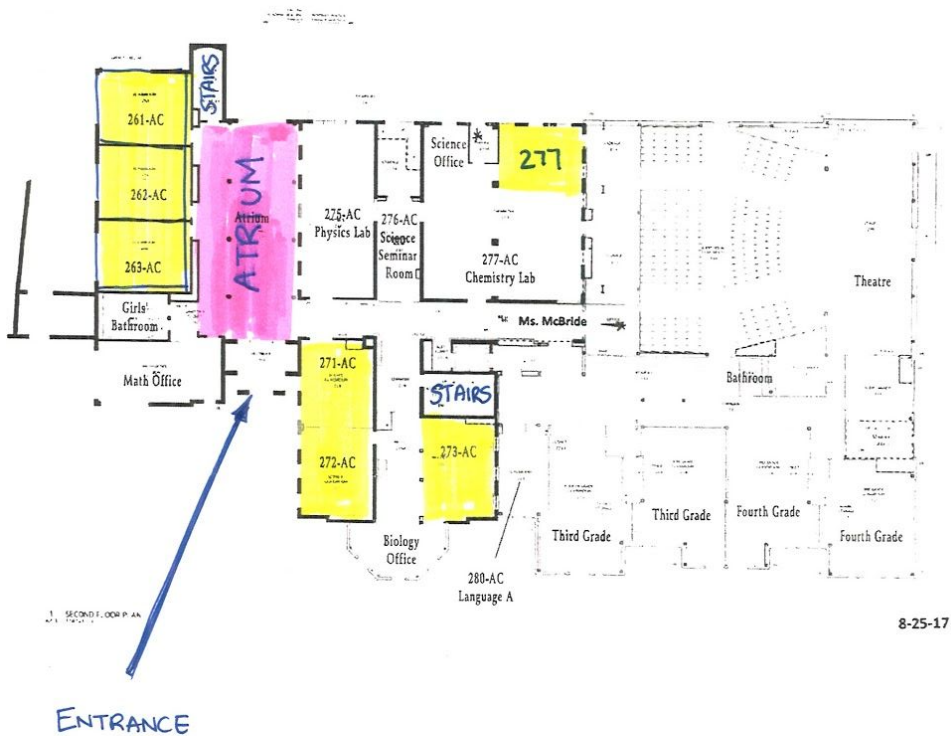
Lunch will be in the cafeteria on the 1st floor.

MAPS

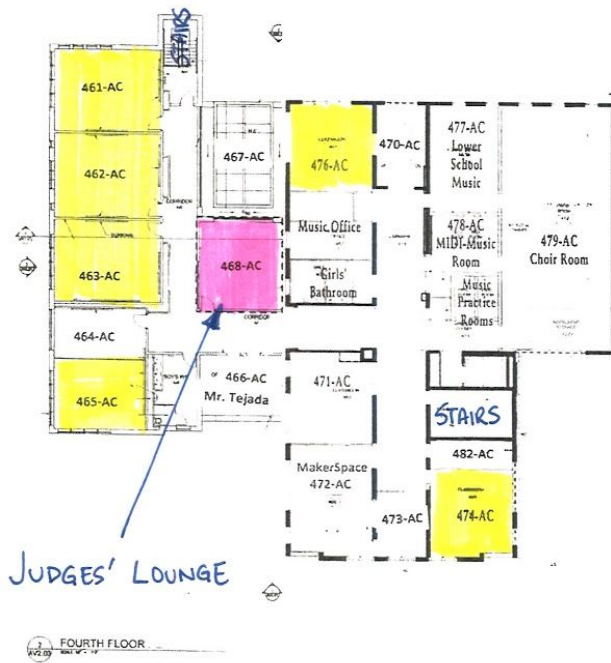
Academic Center & Talbott Hall: SECOND FLOOR

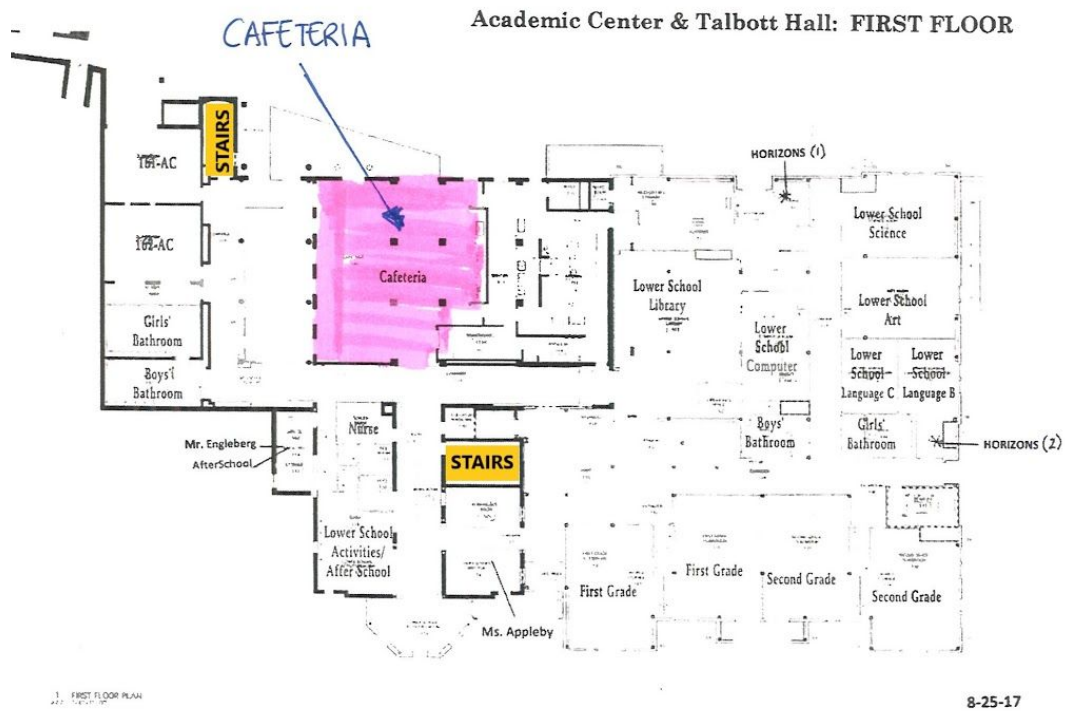


Academic Center & Talbott Hall: THIRD FLOOR
